How will they know?

There is an older “campfire” song that many of us have probably sung back in the day. The chorus basically repeats, “They will know we are Christians by our love.” Not only was this a popular song, but this is also a Biblical concept that is taught in many different locations throughout the Bible. Jesus was definitely harsh and stern with people in the Bible, yet for the most part those people were the religious leaders of the day that believed they were better than everyone else and needed to be broken over their sins by the use of the law. By and large Jesus showed love and compassion throughout His ministry, and constantly administered the gospel.

Instead of reminding the tax collector Matthew (known as Levi at the time) that he was messed up and sinful, Jesus called Matthew to follow Him, and also ate at his house along with other tax collectors and “sinners.” In the Old Testament book of Judges, the people of Israel time and time again turned away from following God, but as soon as they acknowledged their sins, and cried out to God for mercy, God showed compassion and love.

He contracted the disease from his hard partying ways, and homosexual lifestyle. One could argue that he got the results of living his lifestyle. As messed up as Mercury was, he was created in the image of God, and has an eternity to spend in either heaven or hell.

Mercury understood the results of his lifestyle came from his own poor choices. What Mercury needed was not another person reminding him of his past failures, rather he needed someone to model and demonstrate wholesome Christian love. We are surrounded by Freddie Mercurys. We probably all have non-Christian friends, co-workers, neighbors, and even family. What they likely need is not more condemnation, and finger pointing. They need to experience wholesome Christian love. 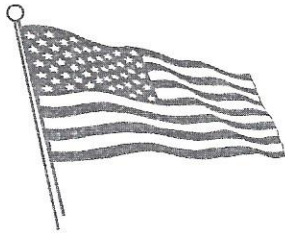
MY COUNTRY

To teach us right, she was resolved!

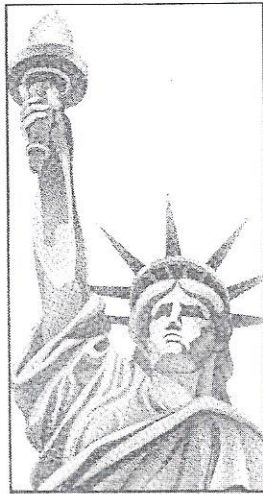
We sang “My Country ’Tis of Thee”,

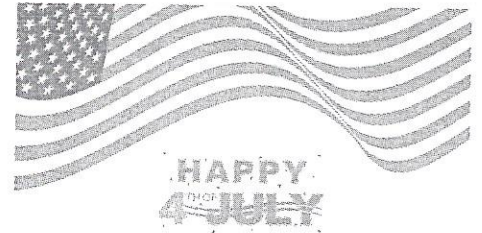
Freedom

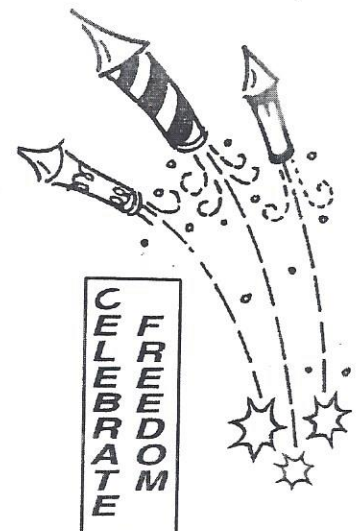

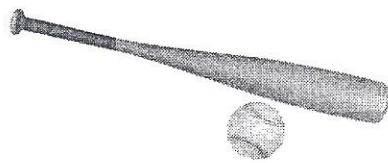
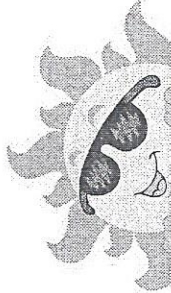

Than with a pole in hand.

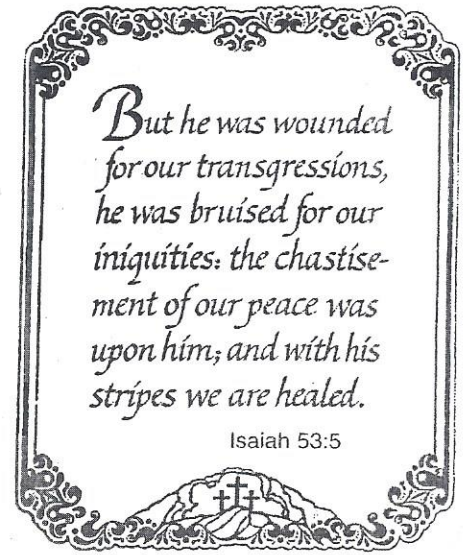

Thank You for the increased time I have to be with my friends and family, and for the more casual pace of the summer season.

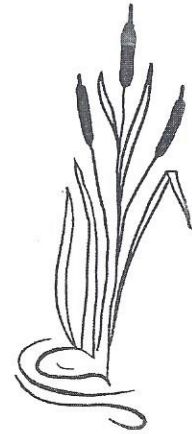
Draw me closer to You this summer.

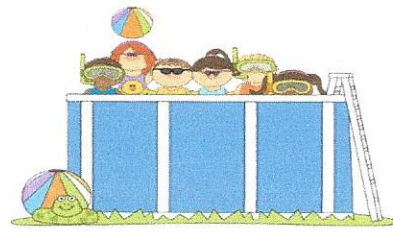
