#### How will they know?

There is an older "campfire" song that many of us have probably sung back in the day. The chorus basically repeats, "They will know we are Christians by our love." Not only was this a popular song, but this is also a Biblical concept that is taught in many different locations throughout the Bible. Jesus was definitely harsh and stern with people in the Bible, yet for the most part those people were the religious leaders of the day that believed they were better than everyone else and needed to be broken over their sins by the use of the law. By and large Jesus showed love and compassion throughout His ministry, and constantly administered the gospel.

We walked to school without a fuss, Through snow and sleet—there was no bus; We took our lunch and liked it fine, Sue traded sandwiches with mine.


Our teacher surely loved the flag. Did not believe our zeal should lag; Where God and Country were involved, To teach us right, she was resolved!
